Entries are confined to Filly Foals, the progeny of a Mare and Sire registered in the I.H.R. and by an approved or S1 Stallion or Weatherby's Non Thoroughbred Register. The Dam's passport must be shown at Qualifying Shows and the foal's ID Certificate at the Final. One Foal from selected shows may qualify, provided the judges and the I.S.A. agree the standard is high enough. Foals must be led at all times. Exhibitors to both the qualifier and the final must have the mare's passport and foal's I.D. Certificate ready for inspection prior to entry to the judging ring. Failure to comply with this rule will lead to immediate disqualification. Where a foal is produced by an embryo transfer method, the dam's passport must bear a declaration dated, stamped and signed by the stallion owner and accredited practitioner. Where AI is used state the date on which the Dam was covered and the name of the stallion. Animals qualified for Final are not eligible to enter any other class at Moate Show other than the qualifying classes for other Finals. Those rules should be read in conjunction with the Irish Shows Association Rules. Entry Fee to Qualifying Show €10. To Final €20.

The mare's passport will be inspected at both the Qualifier and at the Final. All foals MUST be lead both at the qualifier and at the final. Qualifying Rosettes will be awarded at each Show. - CLASS 10 FAILTE IRELAND DUBLIN HORSE SHOW 2009 - RDS Breeders' Championship Qualifier – ENTRY FEE €25**
Final to take place Fáilte Ireland Dublin Horse Show 2009 – 5 – 9 August. This class is open to mares entered in the Irish Horse Register with foal at foot by a sire on the list of approved stallions published by the Irish Horse Board and the Northern Ireland Horse Board. The Class is also open to Thoroughbred mares with foal at foot by a non-thoroughbred sire on the list of approved stallions published by the Irish Horse Board and the Northern Ireland Horse Board. Mares must be free from hereditary unsoundness. In case of doubt, veterinary advice will be sought. The passports of all competing mares must be brought to the qualifying Show for scrutiny by the judges. If the passports are not available at the time of judging the mare will not be eligible to compete. Both mare and foal will be judged on the triangle format and the judges will use a judging sheet with fixed performance criteria when assessing both the mare and foal. The total score for the combination will be as follows;- Mare – Maximum 100. Foal – Maximum 100. A mare and foal which has already qualified for the final may not qualify a second time. The 1st and 2nd prize winners from each qualifier will be eligible to compete in the final of this Championship which will take place during the Fáilte Ireland Dublin Horse Show (5th – 9th of August 2009).

No pre-movement test is required for T.B. However, it is recommended by the Department that a 30 day pre-movement test for TB should apply to all Shows

BRUCELLOSIS STATUS: All animals must come from herds, which are not restricted. All eligible animals (female aged 12 months and over and bulls aged 12 months and over) must have passed a test for Brucellosis within the previous 30 days. However, these animals may move to any number of shows within the validity period of the same 30-day pre-movement test. Where an animal(s) is being shown repeatedly during a succession 30 day validity periods, in the course of a show season, the animal(s) may be allowed to move on foot of Permit ER36A during the unexpired portion of a valid test where the animals is under test for the next validity period and the identity card/passport is held by the DVO/practitioner.

IDENTIFICATION: All cattle must bear double plastic tags issued under the Department's identification system and must be accompanied by their passports.

CMMS NOTIFICATION: The movement of cattle to and from the Show must be recorded on CMMS using form CMMS4 (forms available from your local DVO). The keeper of the animal(s) should complete section 1.3(a) and 4(c) of the CMMS 4 form.

EXHIBITORS must state all details on Entry Form.

ONLY competent persons are allowed to exhibit animals and must wear white coats.

GENERAL RULES & REGULATIONS

01. The last day for receipt of entries is Friday, 15th May 2009. Entries received after that date will not be accepted as this closing date gives our printer the shortest possible time to print the Show Book. Exhibitors are earnestly requested to send entries much earlier than the closing date of May 15th 2009.
02. The Committee reserve the right to refuse any entry, vary the prize list or arrangements or remove any person or any exhibit at any time during the show, and shall not be in any way liable for compensations or otherwise arising out of the holding, abandonment or alteration of the date of the show, or any claim arising out of or concerned with the show.
03. Cheques, Money Orders and Postal Orders to be made payable to "Clonakilty Agricultural Show Ltd".
04. A person entering an exhibit, who fails to send same for exhibition, shall forfeit entry fee.
05. All exhibits in the Horticultural Produce, Cookery and Arts & Crafts, Photography, Class Numbers 01 - 96 inclusive to be removed between 5.00 p.m. and 5.30 p.m. on Sunday, 7th 2009. Exhibitors in these classes must produce to the steward in charge of the respective halls an official removal card.
06. Exhibits which have been sent by bus or post will be conveyed to the show grounds, and returned as soon as possible after the show, but the company will not accept any responsibility for any loss, damage or delay that may occur to the exhibits due to any reason whatsoever, such being the sole risk of the Exhibitor. Cash must be sent for return journey.
07. An attendant in charge of exhibits, other than livestock, must pay full admission fee to show unless able to produce a Show Pass or Membership Card to the Steward at the gate.
08. No prize given unless 2 compete. No 2nd Prize given unless 3 compete. No 3rd prize given unless 6 compete, except where the judges consider there is a special merit and record same in their books at time of judging.
09. First prize winners are debarred from further competition except a horse or pony winning a first prize in an exhibiting class may also compete in a jumping, trotting, dressage or hunter chase competition where eligible. First prize winners in the Dog Section and Pony Section may compete in all eligible classes. Qualifiers are also exempted.
10. The Company will not be responsible for any errors in the Class Book, Entry Forms or Show Book.
11. Each exhibitor to whom a prize is awarded must be prepared, when requested by the Committee, to make a statutory declaration that the conditions and regulation affecting such prize have been compiled with, otherwise the prize shall lapse to the company
12. Owners of Horses and ponies are warned that any act of discourtesy or disobedience to the officials on the part of the exhibitor, owner, attendant or rider will disqualify the horse or pony from adjudication or from taking a prize, and the owner shall forfeit his or her entry fee. 13. Should an objection be made to a successful animal in any class on the basis of age or height, the stewards of the class shall have the animal examined by the Veterinary Surgeon whose decision shall be final.
14. The judges are instructed to withhold a prize where sufficient merit does not appear. The acceptance of Entry Fee by the Secretary shall not be regarded as an admission that the Prize awarded by the judges shall be final unless otherwise provided for in these rules, and not withstanding any error which may be made by the Steward or other official of the company, in placing a prize card on the Exhibit.
15. Objections in any class must be lodged in writing with the Secretary before 5.00 p.m. on the day of the Show accompanied by a fee of €20.00, the fee to be returned if the objection is upheld. Objections will be considered at a later meeting of the Show Committee, whose decision shall be final.
16. EXAMINATIONS OF DOGS MOUTHS - Judges and Veterinary Surgeons are requested to allow exhibitors to open their dogs' mouths to facilitate any necessary examination.
17. The Committee reserve to themselves the right to return or reject any entry without assigning a reason; to cancel a class or competition; or to postpone the Show.
18. A parade of prize winning horses will take place during the Show at a time to be decided by the Stewards of the main arena. A public address announcement shall be deemed sufficient notice of the precise time. Absence of any prize winning animal from the parade will entail forfeiture of the prize or prizes won.
19. The Company will not be accountable for any accident howsoever arising from or for any injury or damage howsoever sustained by any person whether a spectator, exhibitor or otherwise, while in attendance at or within the precincts of the show, or for any damage to cars or other property of whatever nature which have been brought on to the Company's property for whatever purpose.
20. An enclosed parking area for cars (at owners' risk) is provided adjacent to the Show Grounds free of charge.
21. GENERAL: The Company reserves to itself the sole and absolute right to interpret these rules or any other prescribed conditions and regulations on this Class Book and to arbitrarily settle and determine all or any matters or questions or differences in regard thereto, or otherwise arising out of or connected with or incidental to the Show. Also to refuse or cancel entries, disqualify competitors, prohibit exhibitions of entries, vary or cancel awards of prizes or reserved numbers, and relax conditions as the Company may deem expedient: and the decision of the Show Committee shall be final in all respects.
22. The Class Book is subject to the General Rules and Regulations of the Company.
